1. Accumulated –

Meaning: gather together or acquire an increasing number or quantity of.

Synonyms: gather, collect, assemble

Antonyms: dissipate, mangle, blast, liquidate

Usage: “investigators have yet to accumulate enough evidence”

2. Nurtured –

Meaning: care for and protect (someone or something) while they are growing.

Synonyms: bring up, care for

Antonyms: neglect, hinder, stop, clog, inhibit, prevent,

Usage: “Jarrett was nurtured by his parents in a close-knit family”

3. Lethal –

Meaning: very harmful or destructive.

Synonyms: fatal, deadly, mortal

Antonyms: harmless, safe

Usage: “the Krakatoa eruption was the most lethal on record”

4. Contention –

Meaning: heated disagreement.

Synonyms: disagreement, dispute, disputation

Antonyms: agreement

Usage: “the captured territory was the main area of contention between the two countries”
